# Highland Secondary School Sports Academy Hockey

## Program Costs

Similar to extra-curricular programs and curricular programs with an extra-curricular or co-curricular component, there will be costs associated with the program that participants are expected to cover. Tuition Fees will be adjusted in relation to student enrollment numbers:

10 -13 players

Cost per player-----\$400. Deposit + \$1075 = \$1475. plus hst

14-17 players

Cost per player-----\$400. Deposit + \$700. = \$1100. plus hst

18-21 players

Cost per player-----\$400. Deposit + \$600. = \$1000. plus hst

22 or more players

Cost per player-----\$400. Deposit +\$450. = \$850. plus hst

## Payment Format

1. A \$400. Non-refundable deposit for the 2011 / 2012 program is due with the application package after Jan 16<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
2. The remaining amount is due in full no later than Sept 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
3. Payments may be made with Cheque, Money order or cash. All cheques are to be made out to **Leading Edge Hockey Development**. All deposits are non-refundable. No cash refunds after Sept 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

## Program Accountability Requirements

One of the biggest benefits to participating in the academy is the opportunity to put in the consistent "time-on-Task" required to develop and improve ones strength, conditioning and individual skills. Therefore:

1. Program Review, Sept 23rd

2. Academic Review, Oct 11<sup>th</sup>  
Student work ethic and desire to participate in their academic courses will be reviewed. Possible out come may be support intervention and / or a non-refundable discharge from the program.
3. Academic Review, Nov. 11<sup>th</sup>  
Student work ethic and desire to participate in their academic courses will be reviewed. Possible out come may be support intervention and / or a non-refundable discharge from the program.
4. Behavioral Review  
Any student who is suspended from school can expect a possible, non-refundable, discharge from the hockey academy program.
